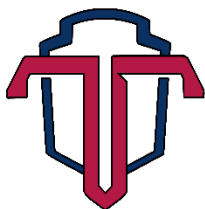


TANGO DOWN TACTICAL, LLC



Hello and thank you for your interest in Tango Down Tactical's NC Concealed Carry Class. This is a detailed outline of the course along with important information you need to know. Here are few FAQ's to go over.

Let's address this first...What happens if I fail the written exam? Or the shooting qualification? Or both?

The very first thing you need to do is take a deep breath. It is going to be ok. I stand by my instruction and if you fail the written part of the exam then I see it as I have failed you and I have not done an adequate job teaching you. The shooting qualification is a bit different. This class is not a "teach you how to shoot class". We simply don't have the time to teach someone the very basics of shooting and get them proficient in the short amount of time we will have at the range. However, should you fail ANY portion of the class we will give you ONE opportunity to retake the class and the exam and/or the shooting qualification at no additional charge. For those who need to retake the range qualification I do recommend spending some time at the range. Preferably, get some instruction on shooting. Tango Down Tactical offers pistol and rifle course and it would be an honor to have you attend one of those classes. You only need to re-do the portion of the class that you did not pass. If you passed the written exam but failed the shooting qualification, then you only need to re-do the shooting. And vice versa. IMPORTANT....there is a time limitation to any re-doing. You MUST complete a re-do within 30 days of your original class date. Anything past 30 days and you will have to pay for and take the entire class again from beginning to end.

Where is the class located?

The class will be held at Tango Down Tactical, LLC located at 519 British Rd, Kinston NC 28501. If you have trouble using a map app or GPS get in touch with me and I will give you detailed driving directions.

Do I need to bring food or beverage? If so, are there any restrictions on what to bring?

Lunch will be provided by us in the form of pepperoni pizza and cheese pizza. We will also have sodas and water bottles available. If you would like to bring your own lunch, then go for it. As for beverages, anything goes so long as it is non-alcoholic of course. We encourage you to bring snacks as well. This is a lengthy class and munching on stuff is just fun.

What items do I need to bring with me to class?

Very important information here. Please bring the following;

- A handgun. Preferably the one you will be using to carry. Any caliber is fine. And revolvers are fine too. Just keep in mind you will be shooting a lot and reloading will make your range qualification longer and your gun will get rather hot.
- 50 rounds of ammunition for the handgun you are bringing. Please no handloads. Factory ammo only.
- A cleaning and maintenance kit for your firearm if you have one.
- Eye protection suitable for shooting sports.
- Ear protection suitable for shooting sports.
- CHECK THE WEATHER FOR THE DAY OF YOUR CLASS!! And dress/prepare appropriately. Our range is an outdoor range. We do provide covered shooting areas. However, rain can blow under the canopies so if rain is in the forecast bring rain gear. IN THE EVENT OF SEVERE WEATHER AND/OR LIGHTNING we will either reschedule the entire class or just the range qualification portion. Otherwise, we will conduct range qualification rain or shine.
- A Government issued form of identification. Driver's License, etc.
- Pen and paper.
- A warm, fuzzy, happy attitude. 😊

What if I don't have a handgun or eye protection or ear protection?

You can rent a handgun from Tango Down Tactical for \$25. Should you need ammo for the rented handgun we can sell that to you. The price for the ammo depends on the handgun you rent. We have eye protection and ear protection that you can use at no charge.

What should I wear?

Please wear pants of some sorts along with closed toe shoes and a comfortable shirt that is not low cut. You will be shooting next to someone and hot brass in a flip flop or on a bare leg or down the front of a shirt is a real bummer. And, most importantly, a major safety hazard.

How long is the class?

The classroom portion will be a minimum of 8 hours. This could go longer depending on questions asked during class. Questions are encouraged. The shooting qualification lasts anywhere from one to two hours depending on many factors. Either way, this is a long class and is well worth my time teaching you and your time educating yourself.

CONCEALED CARRY COURSE REQUIREMENTS

INSTRUCTIONS TO USCCA CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR: In order to provide consistency and quality across the USCCA Instructor network, the following minimum requirements (including the use of the listed PowerPoint slides and videos) must be met when any of the following are true: You are advertising your course as a USCCA course; the certificate you provide at the completion of the course identifies the course as having been a USCCA course; the certificate contains the USCCA logo; or the certificate is a certificate provided by the USCCA.
